TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

Notice is hereby given that on 30 April 2026, the Nueva Ecija II Electric Cooperative, Inc. – Area 1 (NEECO II – Area 1) filed an *Application* dated 31 March 2026, seeking the Commission’s approval of its over-/under-recoveries based on the formula on the various automatic cost adjustment and true-up mechanisms and corresponding confirmation process for the period 2023 to 2025, pursuant to the Commission’s Resolution No. 16, Series of 2009, as amended by

Resolution Nos. 21, and 23, Series of 2010, Resolution No. 02, Series of 2021, and Resolution No. 14, Series of 2022.

The docketed copy of the *Application*, excluding its annexes, is attached as Annex “A” hereof.

The Commission has set the *Application* for hearing, pursuant to the pertinent rules of the Commission, for the determination of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements, expository presentation, and Pre-Trial Conference¹ on **22 June 2026 (Monday), at two o’clock in the afternoon (2:00 PM)**, through **MS Teams Application** as the online platform for the conduct thereof.

Accordingly, Applicant is directed to mirror the virtual hearing, to be hosted by the Commission, at **NEECO II – Area 1’s principal office located at Calipahan, Talavera, Nueva Ecija**, as the designated venue for the conduct thereof and ensure that the same is open to the public. Moreover, Applicant shall guarantee that, during the conduct of the expository presentation, the participation of the public shall not be impaired.

Any interested stakeholder may submit its comments and/or clarifications **at least one (1) calendar day** prior to the scheduled virtual hearing, via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph. The Commission shall give priority to the stakeholders who have duly submitted their respective comments and/or clarifications, to discuss the same and propound questions during the course of the expository presentation.

Moreover, any person who has an interest in the subject matter of the instant case may become a party by filing with the Commission via e-mail at docket@erc.ph, a verified Petition to Intervene **at least five (5) calendar days** prior to the date of the scheduled virtual hearing. The verified Petition to Intervene must follow the requirements under Rule 9 of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure, indicating therein the docket number and title of the case, and state the following:

- 1) The petitioner’s name, mailing address, and e-mail address;
- 2) The nature of petitioner’s interest in the subject matter of the proceeding and the way and manner in which such interest is affected by the issues involved in the proceeding; and

- 3) A statement of the relief desired.

Likewise, all other persons who may want their views known to the Commission with respect to the subject matter of the case may file through e-mail at doCKET@erc.ph, copy furnish the Legal Service through legal@erc.ph, their Opposition or Comment thereon at least five (5) calendar days prior to the scheduled virtual hearing and subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure. No particular form of Opposition or Comment is required, but the document, letter, or writing should contain the following:

- 1) The name, mailing address, and e-mail address of the person;
- 2) A concise statement of the Opposition or Comment; and
- 3) The grounds relied upon.

All interested parties filing their Petition to Intervene, Opposition or Comment are required to submit the hard copies thereof through personal service, registered mail or ordinary mail/private courier, **within five (5) working days** from the date that the same were electronically submitted, as reflected in the acknowledgement receipt e-mail sent by the Commission.

Finally, all interested persons may be allowed to join the scheduled virtual hearing by providing the Commission, through legal.virtualhearings@erc.ph, their respective e-mail addresses, indicating therein the case number of the instant *Application*. The Commission will send the access link/s to the aforementioned hearing platform within five (5) working days prior to the scheduled hearing.
